# Introduction to the World of Adjectives

**Learning Objective:** Students will be able to identify, categorize, and correctly use adjectives in sentences.

## What is an Adjective?

Words that come before nouns to describe them in terms of color, shape, state, or number are called **adjectives**. Adjectives answer the questions "How?" or "Which?" asked to nouns.

**Examples:** \n• **Red** tulip (Color) \n• **Old** house (State) \n• **Round** table (Shape) \n• **Three** apples (Number)
